ERIN SPECIFIC ACTION PROGRAM

The European Reintegration Network (ERIN) program supports returnees from different European countries and Australia (listed in the reverse side). The services are provided to returnees who no longer have the legal basis on which to remain in the host ERIN country and who wish to return to Central and South Iraq.

The ETTC implements this program in Central and South Iraq. The services could be provided on request in the following areas:

Types of support according to program criteria:

Airport pick-up: Reintegration team transports returnees from Airport to their home locations or bus terminals.

Counselling: Introducing the reintegration support packages to the returnee.

Housing: Assisting returnee in finding and/or accessing adequate housing.

Business startup: Developing returnees business idea through training course and market research.

Job Placement: Providing information to the returnee about job opportunities and chances on the labor market and how to apply for jobs.

Vocational Training: Providing vocational training courses for returnees to enhance their skills.

Social and medical support: Providing information on where and how to access public or private health facilities, including mental health care.

Legal support: Supporting returnees with the required administrative requirements of the country.

Family Tracing: Providing family tracing service for UAM.

Monitoring: Following up and monitoring each case during one year. This service is optional according to the host ERIN country.
